Dear Parents and/or Guardians:

Included with this mailing is a registration for the 2009-10 Parish Religious Education year. Our Sessions remain at the same days and times as last year:

**Preschool 4 year olds through Grade 3 -- Sundays 10:30 - 11:45am**

**Grades 4 through 7 -- Mondays 6:45 - 8:15pm**

**Grades 8 and 9 (Teen Faith Program) – Sunday or Monday 6:45pm – 8:15pm**

Teen Faith sessions are based on Catechist availability and student participation.

**Confirmation Candidates will meet once/month Sept. – Dec., then twice/month Jan. – April.**

Each child's registration should include:

- 1. Registration Form** (*provided*). This form should be Completed (or updated), signed and dated including The Medical Authorization Form on the reverse side of the form.
- 2. Copy of Baptism Certificate.** This document is required for ALL 2<sup>nd</sup> graders and for ALL Confirmation Candidates that were not baptized at St. Mary Berea. Please contact the REO if you have any questions as to whether this document is already on file with our office.
- 3. Fees paid in full\***

### 2009- 10 REO Registration Fees

1 Child	\$ 65.00
2 Children	\$ 55.00 / child
3 or more	\$ 50.00 / child
Sacramental Fee	\$ 20.00 (2 <sup>nd</sup> grade & Confirmation only)

The Teen Faith Program follows the above fee schedule. If you are paying for individual multi-week session the cost is \$20/session.

Any registration after October will be charged an additional \$10 / child "late" fee to process the registration.

**There is a maximum \$200.00 registration fee for any family.**

For the first time since 2004, we are being forced to increase all registration fees. This change is necessary to keep up with ever-increasing costs for books, people & materials.

Please review, revise where appropriate and return the registration forms enclosed to the Religious Education Office no later than Monday August 10, 2009. A child will be registered when the completed forms are received and fees are paid in full.
